The Bermuda Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Bermuda SPCA) is a, non-profit organization founded in 1919 and incorporated under ACT 21, 1921. And is registered as Charity No. 86 under the Bermuda Charities Act. The Bermuda SPCA's mission is to provide effective, lawful means for the prevention of cruelty to animals, promote the education of the general public on the care and well-being of all animals, and encourage and promote kindness to animals.

We depend on volunteers from the community and with your generous support, we are able to feed, and give much needed medical attention to the homeless animals in our community.

If you are a student that needs to perform community service for a community project or would just like to help the animals at the Bermuda SPCA, there are several different things that you can do. The following list is provided to offer project ideas.

How It Works

1. Choose a project/projects or activity from the lists below, or propose an idea of your own.
2. Track volunteer hours – *the number of hours to be earned for each task is listed along side the item*. There is a log sheet provided.
3. When your project is completed, please contact the Bermuda SPCA to schedule a time to drop off your projects and to get your service hours log signed. Please email info@spca.bm to schedule drop off time.

Fundraising Ideas

1. Ask friends/family members/neighbors for donations. See below list for supplies that we use on a regular basis, or check out our wish list.
2. Put a donation bin at a local business.
3. Make crafts/DIY items to sell.
4. Do chores or yard work in exchange for money/donation items.
5. Ask for donations for your birthday, Christmas, etc. instead of gifts for yourself.
6. Write donation request letters to people in the community.
7. Set up an online fundraiser.
8. Check out our doggie day out program. Youth must have an adult guardian present to participate.

Donation drive ideas

- Cat litter: 5 containers/bags = 1 hr.
- Hot Dogs: 10 packages = 1 hr.
- Canned Kitten & Adult Cat Food: 12 cans = 1 hr.
- Dog/Cat Toys: 20 toys = 1 hr.
- Canned Puppy & Adult Dog Food: 12 cans = 1 hr.
- Kong Medium/Large: 1 = 1 hr.
- Kong Small: 2 = 1 hr.
- Dog/Cat Training Treats: 5 lbs. = 1 hr.
- Dry Dog/ Cat Food: 5 bags = 1 hr.
- Small Animal Bedding (shavings no wood chips please!): 2 bags = 1 hr
- Muffin tins: 5 tins = 1 hr.
